

Online library catalogue: NEBIS I


- **NEBIS:** The ZHAW University Library is a member of the *Network of Libraries and Information Centres in Switzerland (NEBIS)*, which is a network of around 140 Swiss libraries with a total collection of about 11 million titles. Many of these items can be delivered to the library in Wädenswil.






