

INTERNSHIP IN ENGLISH EDITING AND TERMINOLOGY

The Language Services Support Section at the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) is offering internships in English editing and terminology in 2020 for a period of 3 to 6 months. Graduates may apply up to one year after the completion of their master's degree in a language-related subject. Interns are eligible to receive a stipend of up to €1000 per month. The actual period of internship will be discussed with the selected candidate, also taking into account possible travel restrictions related to COVID-19.

Candidates must:

- have an excellent command of English as their mother tongue;
- have knowledge of another United Nations language;
- have a general interest in the IAEA's work.

- a letter of motivation, including details of their availability in 2020.

Deadline for applications: **12 June 2020**.

Selected applicants will be invited to do an English editing and terminology test to determine their suitability for the internship.
