## Looking for Student Helpers

We are looking for student assistants who are interested in helping out at this large upcoming linguistics conference during the summer recess. The conference is scheduled to take place both on the Winterthur Campus of ZHAW School of Applied Linguistics (Theaterstrasse/ St. Georgenplatz) and online.

Students interested in working with us should be free for working hours during all of the conference week and are required to take part in a training session some time before the conference in order to become familiarized with the online system, campus facilities and technical tools. Students who have been accepted as student helpers to the IPrA Conference will have free access to the conference and are payed on an per-hour basis as student helpers.

The International Pragmatics Conference is a biannual international event organised by the International Pragmatics Association in conjunction with a university, this time with ZHAW's School of Applied Linguistics, and for the first time in Switzerland. It is a major international conference bringing together up to 1300 people, researchers, students and internationally renowned figures in the field of linguistics. The conference language is English.

All student assistants are paid at the student tariff of CHF 20.-/hour and can attend lectures free of charge when they are not on duty. The exact working schedule will be jointly agreed upon.
